Message of the Vice Chancellor

It is indeed a great pleasure to send this congratulatory message on the occasion of the 44th General Convocation of the University of Sri Jayewardenepura which is to be held on the 6th and 7th of September 2018. First, I would like to warmly congratulate both undergraduate and postgraduate students of the university who will be conferred upon their respective degrees today. A celebration is due as it is your unwavering effort, dedication and perseverance that earned you this success. Therefore, I take great pride in sending this message for this glorious moment of your life.

The roots of the University of Sri Jayewardenepura can be traced back to its noble beginnings in 1873 as Vidyodaya Pirivena located in Maligakanda which was founded by the most venerable Hikkaduwe Sri Sumangala Thero. The Pirivena gained University status in 1958 by the Parliamentary Act of Vidyodaya and Vidyalankara Universities. The Vidyodaya University of Ceylon was then ceremoniously opened on the 16th of February 1959 under the leadership of the most Venerable Welivitiye Sri Soratha Thero who was the Principal of the Pirivena at that time. Vidyodaya University then became the University of Sri Jayewardenepura in 1978.

At the beginning the University hosted only 366 students in five faculties. Today the University of Sri Jayewardenepura is the largest University in Sri Lanka with yearly enrolments amounting to over 13,000 students. The university comprises seven faculties: Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences, Faculty of Applied Sciences, Faculty of Management Studies and Commerce, Faculty of Medical Sciences, Faculty of Graduate Studies, Faculty of Technology and the Faculty of Engineering. I am proud to say that the University of Sri Jayewardenepura has over 17 fully developed active research centers which are conducting research on such vital areas as Cancer, Dengue, Herbal Medicine, and Nano technology.

Our annual student intake rate has steadily increased and will continue to do so with future developments. We consider our students as our prime responsibility and hence, we have always strived to cater to their requirements. Within the last few years we were able to increase the hostel capacity by 53%. We have further initiated creating a self-sustaining environment, starting at the student level encouraging entrepreneurship. With the current student employability rate of 90% within the first six months, I can confidently say that the students who graduate from the University of Sri Jayewardenepura are sufficiently capable and cultured to face challenges and evolving needs of the economy and the country.

As medical students in all State medical faculties kept away from academic work for nearly 10 months last year, protesting over sub standard private medical education, a main batch of medical graduands are not available for the conferment of MBBS degrees today

In keeping with the Faculty goals, the medical and health graduates produced by Faculty of Medical Sciences of USJ are enriched with the necessary knowledge, skills, attitudes and mind set to provide health care services in any part of Sri Lanka.

The Faculty of Medical Sciences of USJ is the first Faculty to enroll the Diploma holders of Nursing, Pharmacy and Medical Laboratory Technologists of Ministry of Health through the lateral entry pathway to undergraduate courses to obtain degree level qualifications. Some of them are among the graduands to be conferred with degrees to-day.
